upon him by post addressed to him at the Property and that if there are any subsisiting breaches of the obligations of the Original Covenantee contained in the said Deed of Grant then for the purpose of this Deed of Covenant such breach shall be deemed to first occur immediate after the date of this Deed of Covenant

gender and vice versa and expressions importing the singular number refer where

applicable to the plural number and vice versa

3.2 Where there are two or more persons included in the Covenantee the covenants

expressed to be made by the Covenantee shall be deemed to be made by such persons
